

Motus Theater COVID-19 Policies for In-Person Events

(The Show Doesn't Have to Go On - But YOU Do!)

To take care of each other (performers, staff and community), Motus has established new pandemic-conscious policies. These policies are based on <u>CDC</u>, <u>state</u>, and <u>local government</u> guidelines as well as on the policies of leading arts and community organizations such as Cleo Parker Robinson Dance Studio, and the Denver Center for the Performing Arts. We appreciate your patience and flexibility as we grow and adapt together during this unprecedented time.

At this moment, Motus Theater is not requiring proof of vaccination or negative tests from presenters, volunteers, or audience members. Motus Theater staff will consult with presenters before each show on whether they would like the group of artists and staff who will be rehearsing and presenting together on stage to be tested before the start of rehearsals and we will defer to the most sensitive part. (Motus Theater staff is vaccinated.)

Motus Theater encourages staff, presenters, and volunteers who are not involved in rehearsals or speaking on stage, as well as our audience, to wear a mask. We ask staff, presenters, volunteers, and audience members to respect individuals who choose to wear masks as a precaution.

<u>NOTE:</u> Motus abides by the COVID-19 mitigation policies for audiences applied by the venues in which we perform.
